6 Proposed Intervenor-Defendants DCCC and California Democratic Party (together,

15 resolution of the Motion would therefore serve the interests of judicial efficiency and ensure that
16 Proposed Intervenor-Defendants are able to protect their rights and interests.

17 Accordingly, Proposed Intervenor-Defendants respectfully request the following schedule:

- 18 • Any responses to Proposed Intervenor-Defendants’ Motion to Intervene as Defendants shall
19 be filed on or before Friday, June 5, 2020; and
- 20 • Proposed Intervenor-Defendants shall file a reply on or before Monday, June 8, 2020.

[PROPOSED] ORDER
