## FOCUSING ON US, AT HOME

### Protecting lives and livelihoods in the midst of COVID-19

Secured \$9 billion for family farms and fought to make farmers eligible for small business loans. Wrote the bipartisan Direct Support for Communities Act, providing local governments with money to help pay teachers, firefighters and frontline workers.

### Lowering the cost of health care

Introduced the Medicare-X Choice Act, creating a public option through Medicare while allowing people satisfied with their private insurance to keep it. He's voted for measures to lower the cost of prescription drugs and allow the government to negotiate with drug companies.

### Making small business a top priority

Awarded the Spirit of Enterprise Award by the US Chamber of Commerce for supporting small business. Wrote a bill helping small businesses cut through red tape and his bill to provide automatic loan relief to small businesses struggling during COVID-19 was signed into law. Antonio has been endorsed by the US Chamber of Commerce.

### Revitalizing family farms and rural communities

Congressman Delgado's Family Farmer Relief Act—allowing struggling farmers to restructure their debt—is now law. Also, he's secured more funding for high-speed internet and cell phone coverage in rural New York and introduced the Rebuild Rural America Act to invest in local infrastructure projects.



In 2018, when Antonio Delgado pledged to listen to us and be our voice in Congress, he meant every word. And clearly, he still does.

Antonio has proudly served the people of New York's 19th Congressional District with transparency, accessibility and accountability – even during a time of crisis. He's been a presence in every corner of our District, holding 35 in-person town halls, more than 10 virtual town halls and scores of meetings with constituents.

In Washington DC, Antonio is a leader on agriculture, rural infrastructure, health care and veterans' issues. He has worked with both parties to get things done—writing the Family Farmer Relief Act, the Small Business Repayment Relief Act, and introducing a bill allowing people to buy into Medicare.

And when our country and our communities faced the unprecedented crisis of COVID-19, Antonio responded to the massive challenges – working to provide relief for our small businesses and our rural economy, and resources for essential frontline workers.

There's so much more left to do—and no one is more suited to make change happen and get things done than Antonio Delgado.
