

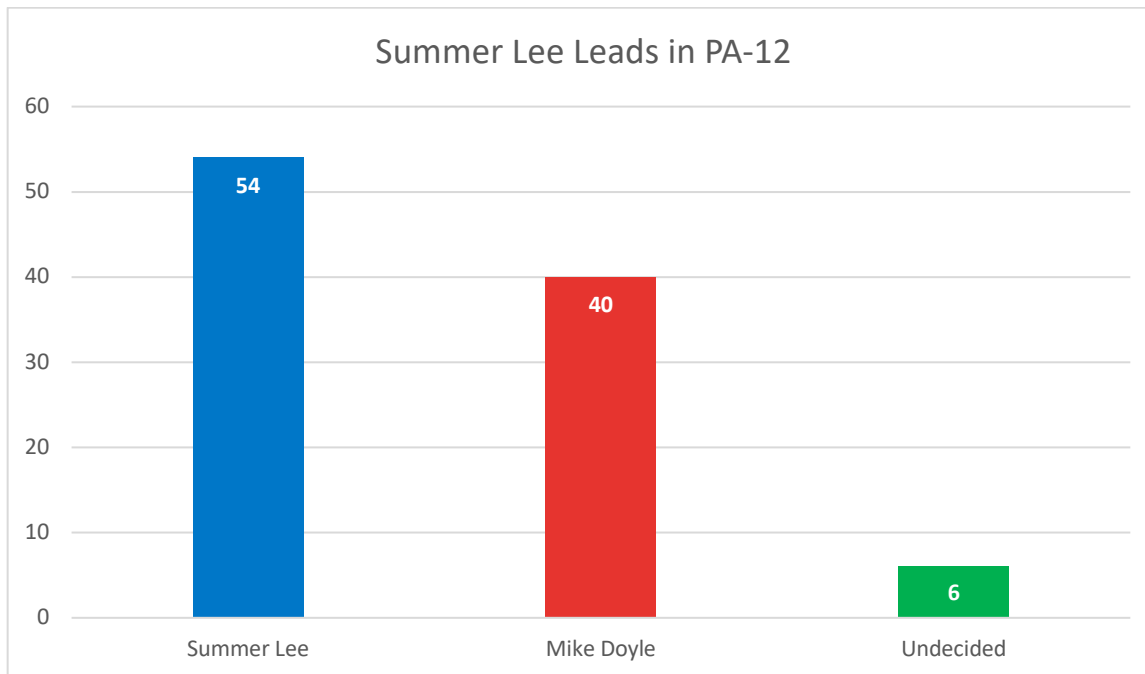

Subject: Summer Lee Leads by 14 Points in PA-12

SUMMER LEE ENJOYS A STRONG LEAD

Democrat Summer Lee leads Republican Mike Doyle by 14-points, 54% to 40% with 6% undecided in this Pittsburgh-area congressional district, well beyond the poll's +/-3.5-point margin of error. Lee's performance tracks just behind Senate candidate John Fetterman, who enjoys a 20-point lead in this district, 58% to 38% with 4% undecided. A generic Democrat leads a generic Republican by 19 points, 57% to 38% with 5% undecided.



Methodology: These results are based on a survey of 785 likely 2022 general election voters in Pennsylvania's 12th congressional district, conducted by DCCC Analytics from October 30-31, 2022, using a mix of live callers and text-to-web. The margin of error is +/-3.5 points at a 95% confidence interval, with larger margins of error for demographic subgroups.

About the District: Pennsylvania's 12th congressional district includes Pittsburgh and its suburbs. It includes the southwest portion of Allegheny, County along with western Westmoreland County. In 2020 Joe Biden won 59.4% of this district.
