- Oversee daily operations, including volunteer recruitment, phonebanks, canvass launches, turf cutting, visibility, and other key activities.
- Manage the campaign's voter contact and volunteer data and records.
- Communicate regularly with the Campaign Manager to report daily results and troubleshoot challenges.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 1-2 years experience in field organizing or other relevant campaign work.
- Strong familiarity with voter contact platforms (VAN, Mobilize, etc.) and ability to train staff.
- Strong organizational skills and a talent for multitasking.
- Ability to work from the Flushing, Queens campaign office and maintain flexible working hours. Access to a car is required.
- Multilingual skills are a plus.
